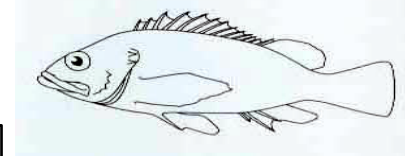
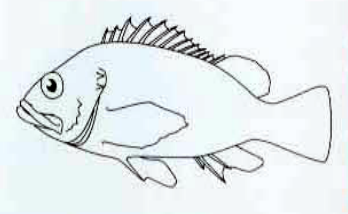

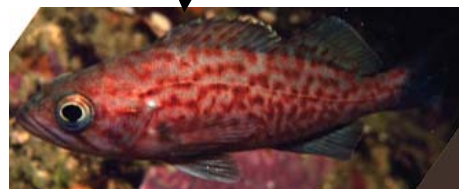
Elongate body

Brown bars on light body  
(KGB complex)



No white dorsal spots, clear tail,  
uniform color  
Black (SMEL)

'Y' on 4th bar  
Kelp (SATR)



Clearing on lateral line  
Copper (SCAU)



No 'Y', no clearing, but big enough  
to have these markings  
Gopher-Black/yellow (GBY)



White dorsal spots, yellow fins  
(including pectoral)  
Olive-yellowtail complex (OYT)
